## CRAWFORD RIVER YOUNG VINES RIESLING 2012 HENTY, VICTORIA

What started out as young vines on the Crawford River Estate has now largely become 16 year old vines & very close in quality to it's big brother – the Crawford River Riesling. This is an excellent introduction to arguably Australia's best riesling producer. Abundant lemon, lime, passionfruit, ginger spice and apple are all woven into a juicy fresh palate. ### SORRENBURG CHARDONNAY 2012 BEECHWORTH, VICTORIA

Consistently one of our absolute favourite Australian chardonnay's and the 2012 is no different. Perhaps a touch richer than the previous vintage but with similar elegance and effortless intensity of flavour. Yellow florals, wax and cashew nut dominate the bouquet whilst the palate shows peach, almond and a touch of minerality which is softened by the seamless inclusion of toasty vanilla oak. There are hints of minerality too which are aided by tightly coiled acidity which suggest the wine has a number of years ahead of it.

### PIEROPAN SOAVE 2013 VENETO, ITALY

Pieropan is by far the greatest producer in Soave and can be judged on his simplest Soave. It is very expressive and typical – predominately garganega with a little trebbiano di Soave. Pale straw with green reflections; the bouquet is rich in floral, almond and mineral scents. The fresh persistent palate is dominated by almond, apple and white flowers – crisp and fresh and perfect with chicken cacciatore or grilled tuna belly. In fact it drinks well with a whole range of foods and keeps all sorts of palates happy. Like our delicate Australian Semillon, this wine really benefits from its screwcap closure. The best ever from Pieropan.

### YALUMBA THE SIGNATURE CABERNET SHIRAZ 2012 BAROSSA VALLEY, SA

Impenetrable inky black core with a very deep dark crimson black hue. The nose shows good perfumed lift with aromas of ripe blackcurrants, blackberries and subtle dark chocolate intensifying with air time, followed by some liquorice, toasty vanillin oak and spice. Full bodied, rich bold flavours of ripe blackcurrants, dark chocolate, blackberries and liquorice swamp the palate with underlying vanillin cedar and spice. The wines richness is perfectly counterpointed by the solid, almost muscular like tannin structure. Excellent length with a long conclusion of ripe blackberries, blackcurrant, liquorice, chocolatey oak and vanillin spice. An amazing wine to have with a big Capitol steak.

### GABA DO XIL MENCIA 2011 VALDEORRAS, SPAIN

D.O. Valdeorras is the eastern-most wine zone in Galicia – travel further east and you end up in the high, continental hills of Bierzo and the ancient kingdom of Leon. The Mencia grape is a native of the north-west – both the continental province of Leon and Atlantic-influenced Galicia. Despite it clearly being the best red wine variety (of dozens) native to Galicia, outright rusticity in production and elevation of fruit means that until now little good (let alone, interesting) wine has been made from the variety. But, that’s all changing rapidly ... historically, considered to come from the Cabernet Franc cultivar, but evolution sees it an independent variety offering a range of likenesses – Northern Rhone, Beaujolais and Burgundy comparisons are appropriate. This wine itself is highly fragrant and floral, with rose petal, pomegranate, blackcurrant and spice aromatics. Trademark Mencia smoky meatiness, gentle fruit tannin and a long herb/acid tang finish. Mid-weight, delicious and very stylish wine. Great current drinking falling somewhere between pinot noir and shiraz.

### PIZZINI SANGIOVESE 2013 KING VALLEY, VICTORIA

Sangiovese is the grape variety of Chianti in Tuscany. Pizzini makes one of the very best examples in Australia. The nose is vibrant and fresh, intensely perfumed with lifted notes of plums, spice, red berries and dark cherries. As the wine opens there are lovely herbal and savoury characters with dark cherry fruit as it's core flavour. It has chalky tannins that line the palate and woody spice notes. Flavours of plum, spiced cherries and earthy tones run through the palate providing length. A charming, medium bodied, European style wine.
